

GENERAL INFORMATION

a) The internal and external administration of the school shall be conducted in French including oral and written communication to students, staff and parents. All general and/or group meetings shall be conducted in French*.

*Some schools may choose to have special parent committees who may translate written external communications on request, to facilitate communications with English-speaking parents. Parents may phone the school principal whenever they wish, if they need clarification.

b) Verbal communication on a one-to-one basis may be conducted in French or in English in matters concerning his/her child.

c) Parents, making the request, will be interviewed by the admissions committee of the local school.

d) The child will receive French language programming at his/her level.

e) Progress reports on the child's development will be conducted in accordance with the evaluation mechanism set up by the school's French programming, and will be discussed on a regular basis with the parents.

f) All students will be expected to take part in cultural activities, the cultural component being an important part of the curriculum.
